Lutheran Community Services Northwest is owned by the synods of Region 1 and uses government contracts to provide public social services otherwise difficult to find. Current work includes the Sexual Assault and Family Trauma Center; children with Problematic Sexual Behaviors; International and Domestic Foster Care; Crime Victim Service Center; and Human Trafficking Information and resources. Throughout Washington, Oregon and Idaho, LCS Northwest offers real solutions through more than 100 local programs for over 60,000 people a year. LCS-NW is the most basic way the church offers public social ministry in the healing name of Jesus Christ.

Lutheran Community Services Northwest is a nonprofit human-services agency dedicated to empowering and healing children, individuals and families in crisis within our community since 1956. Working with accredited therapists and highly effective programs, we offer support to people whose lives are broken from trauma, helping them to pick up the pieces and feel whole again by building on their personal strengths to help them find safety, stability and permanency.

LCS Northwest serves victims of trauma throughout Eastern Washington and Idaho, including abused and neglected children, sexual assault survivors, child and adult victims of human trafficking, crime and assault victims, refugee people and foster children. LCS Northwest touches the lives of people of all ages, cultures and faith find hope, resources and strength to heal and become contributing members of our communities. Majority of LCS Northwest clients represent under-served and marginalized populations.
